## Emo CRC's July 3rd Update

Your Council would like to provide you an update of what's happening with respect to the Christian Reformed Church here in Emo this week:

- As stated earlier this is a fluid situation and our planned service for Sunday, July 12 will be pushed back to the 19th. In discussion with our local health unit it has been determined that singing is not yet permitted under stage 2. Since singing is a core component of our worship service, we decided to postpone services until singing can be safely incorporated. Council is waiting for direction from the government regarding potential movement to stage 3, which will hopefully allow singing during worship services and increase participation. The date of July 19th for a worship service may change; an update will be provided as it becomes available.
- The nominations for elders and deacons are John Sinninghe, Gerald Veldhuisen and Peter Veldhuisen for the office of elder (2 positions to be filled) and Colin Kaemingh and Mike Veldhuisen for the office of deacon (2 positions to be filled). If you have any questions, please contact your elder. We will be using the eBallot process again for the congregation's vote of affirmation for the names above; originally this was scheduled to occur from July 1st 3rd, but has been rescheduled for July 3rd to July 7th at 6:00 PM. The elders will contact those who cannot use the eBallot process. The ordination service will occur when we are able to meet again.
- We are still waiting to hear from Immigration and Citizenship regarding Dr. Marno's application. It has been approximately 5 weeks since the application has been submitted. Dr Marno is continuing to work with CMLT on his Article 8 process.
