Your Council would like to provide you an update of what's happening with respect to the Christian Reformed Church here in Emo this week:

- Our service is planned for this Sunday, October 18. The Worship Committee continues to work alongside Pastor Marno to plan Sunday services. The services will include both live and online components. Worship Lyric Videos will continue to be incorporated into the service to hum or meditate on the lyrics. Songs will be incorporated at the end of the service to sing outside (weather permitting). Please remember that attending the service is ultimately your decision; you are not required to attend. Face masks will be provided in the foyer if you need one. Do not attend if you have a cough, fever, or do not feel well. The service would include a controlled entrance and exit policy and physical distancing measures will continue to be in place.
